Where did it come from?


imAGES programme

Developed by Sibila Marques within the framework of the SIforAGE

The imAGES programme was designed with the objective of changing stereotypes and myths of young students regarding older people.


imAGES Evaluation




The evaluation of the impact of the programme showed that students involved had a **significant change** in the representation of ageing after the intervention, expressing a **more positive view of older people.**

Intervention Programme Model

The original imAGES programme identified and was based on five factors referred in the literature as having a possible influence in changing negative stereotypes (Marques 2014).

By developing this programme, the project contributed to **mitigate** stereotypes and negative attitudes in health and social professionals, regarding sexuality in old age, in particular regarding LGBTI people.








